MESSAGE FROM MISS DARLENE:

How can we create a safe and healthy care environment with the support of our families which keep our children, staff from getting exposed and getting sick and our families from missing work.

At The Little Mud Puddles, we do have procedures in place to keep everyone healthy, especially for pregnant women who could be affected by some childhood diseases that could harm their unborn babies. Also there are some concerns with those with underlining illnesses. Here are a few reminders:

- You are to email LMP at littlemudpuddles@aol.com if your child is out sick due to a contagious illness such as pink eye, COVID, severe flu, severe cough, unknown rash, diarrhea or vomiting. We have had children come to school with diarrhea which is very difficult to manage and to keep children clean. Children are not allowed to come with diarrhea.
- When we call you to pick up your child with a concern of a contagious illness, we require that they are picked up within the hour, so other children, staff are not exposed.
- When your child has a fever over 100 degrees F or higher, he/she must be fever free 24 hours before attending school without the use of fever reducing medications. High fevers can cause seizures.
- A doctor's note may be requested to return to school which states that the child is not contagious. You must ask the doctor to state this on the note.
- All prescriptions shall include the child's name, date, doctor's name, and how the prescription is to be administered. Prescriptions must be in its original packaging.

I truly understand since I am the Director/Owner of LMP how difficult it is to leave your work, but the only way we can keep everyone safe is with your cooperation. Thank you, Miss Darlene

VACATION SIGN-UP


Please sign the clipboard in our front office if you plan on taking vacation.

Please remember that children must be in school by 9:00 a.m. We open early – 7:00 a.m. for your convenience. Your child – because they are late - may be missing out on some fun projects the teachers have planned. You will be charged a late fee of \$20 if you come in at 9:16 a.m. Same thing in the evening, at 6:01 p.m., the late fee begins.

If you are planning on travelling by plane, please make sure your child takes a COVID test before returning to school. All results must be sent to littlemudpuddles@aol.com prior to coming to school. Also, if your child has any cold like symptoms, we may require you to COVID test your child. RSV is also contagious, and your child should be tested if he/she has any symptoms.

If your child has been out ill for more than a couple of days, do test them for COVID and/or RSV before returning to school. Send results to littlemudpuddles@aol.com not Lillio. It is extremely important that we keep all children, families, and staff safe.
